

THE IMPACT OF LOW LITERACY

In the United States, more than 48 million adults cannot read, write, or do basic math above a third-grade level.



Adults with limited literacy are hospitalized and use emergency services at significantly higher rates than those with higher skills.

Reversing this trend is estimated to save between

\$106 - \$238 BILLION

each year in health care costs in the U.S.

Bringing all adults to the equivalent of a sixth-grade reading level would generate an additional \$2.2 trillion in annual income for the country.

A mother's reading skill is the greatest determinant of her children's future academic success, outweighing other factors, such as neighborhood and family income.

During the 2023-2024 academic year, 211 adult students have received over 8500 hours of instruction through 9 classes and 45 1:1 tutor pairs, supported by 5900 hours of volunteer literacy tutor time.
